The <u>district of Borken</u> ∠, in cooperation with the <u>self-help contact point Kreis Coesfeld /</u> <u>Kreis Borken</u> ∠, maintains a database of local self-help groups and self-help organisations at <u>Selbsthilfenetz.de</u> This helps people to cope better with their illness or disability, as the groups can often offer a wide range of options for solving problems. Participation in life



Supplementary independentparticipation counselling(EUTB) **supports you with questions about participation**. For example, if you have questions about assistance or aids or if you want to know what a participation plan is.

It is offered on a low-threshold basis and independently of service providers and service providers. Local counselling is possible at the **EUTB Kreis Borken - Büro Borken Z**.
