The special film: "Golda - Israel's Iron Lady"

Biopic about Israeli Prime Minister Golda Meir // Tuesday, 24 September, at 8 pm in the Kinodrom // Admission 6 euros or Culture Pass

On Tuesday, 24 September, the city of Bocholt is presenting the biopic "Golda - Israel's Iron Lady" as part of the "The Special Film" series. The political thriller sheds light on the work of former Israeli Prime Minister Golda Meir during the Yom Kippur War in the early 1970s. It starts at 8 pm in the Kinodrom.

The city of Bocholt invites cinema fans and those interested in culture. Admission costs 6 euros and is free for holders of the culture pass.

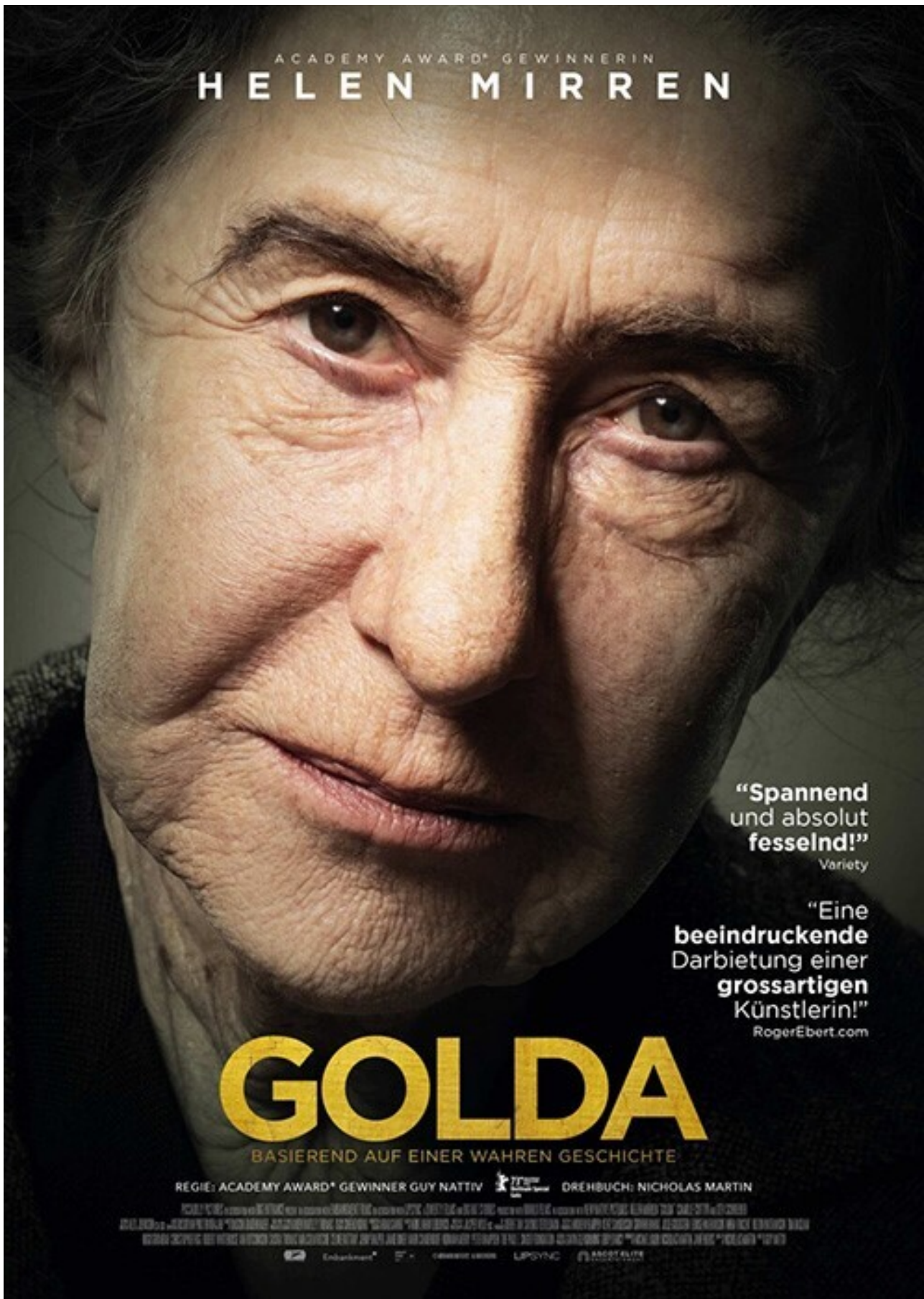
