Applying digitally: online seminar for women in Bocholt

On Thursday, 14 November, the city of Bocholt is offering an online seminar for women on the topic of "Digital Application".

Content and registration

Participants will gain an insight into the requirements of modern online applications. The event is aimed at women who want to modernise their application strategies or find out about digital application procedures. The event starts at 7 pm.

Digital applications have overtaken traditional paper applications and are favoured by most companies. This should be prepared just as carefully as a traditional application. It is important to be aware of the digital pitfalls that need to be avoided.

The seminar also answers common questions such as "Can I have my application created by AI systems such as ChatGPT?" and provides instructions on how to use digital application platforms safely. Women who have not applied for a long time and would like to learn about the latest application rules can benefit from the content, as can those who want to stay up to date with applications in general.
